Runcorn Food Bank

The foodbank is currently requesting donations of:
**Tinned Fruit, Tinned Potatoes, Custard, Long Life Milk,
Tinned or Packet Soup, Sanitary Products**

Thank to all parishioners who are continuing to support the Foodbank throughout Winter.

All donations are welcome – both financial and goods – especially at this time of year.

In October, 202 vouchers were issued and the Foodbank provided food and other essential to 285 adults and 181 children. This is vital as a recent report from Trussell shows that the percentage of UK households in food insecurity increased from 14% in 2022 to 16% in 2024. Continued support such as this have enabled the Foodbank to provide 2.72 tonnes of food and household essentials per month in our area.
